We suggest a minimum Spanish level of B1, for a better understanding and use in classes.

SPANISH CLASSES

Two Spanish courses are offered per semester.
They are by requirement, a group of at least 5 students must subscribe.
Spanish courses have extra cost.

Intensive course:

- 2 weeks, before regular semester starts.
- Includes 30 class hours + 10 Culture class hours + city tours.

- Ideal to soak in the Yucatecan culture.

- Approximate cost: 350 USD

Regular course:

- 10 weeks during regular semester.

- Includes 30 class hours, 3 hours a week.

- Approximate cost: 180 USD
